### **Black and White Photography**

Color photography is seductive. It's bright and vibrant. It sings. But B&W does something color can't do. It brings our attention to the structure, the elements, the heart of the story. It can dazzle us with complexity inherent in the simplicity of the tones.

When people think of black and white landscape photography they often think of one man: Ansel Adams. His black and white photography is influential due to its sharp focus and tonal range. Alongside Fred Archer, he helped develop the 'zone system' – a complex technique used to determine optimal film exposure and development. Read more:
